### Recent webinar

A webinar on FEMA's Future of Flood Risk Data initiative is scheduled for November 28, 2023. The webinar on FFRD will be presented by Christina Lindemer.

### Future CTP webinars

The webinar that was suggested by Shubha Shrivastava, Mitigation Planner, in the Planning & Safety Branch of FEMA's Risk Management on "Integrating floodplain management planning and mitigation planning to maximize CRS participation and benefits" will be held during the January to March, 2023 timeframe. There have been some changes made to the guidance to better align the two processes so that local communities can maximize their CRS points when they develop/update their mitigation plan.

2D modeling – The 2D Integrated Planning Team effort has been suggested for a webinar. The 2D modeling efforts associated with the 2D IPT could then be the topic for the April – May timeframe.

### ASFPM Project

ASFPM has been funded to interview communities that have received floodways developed with 2D modeling. The areas where communities have been identified are South Dakota, Kentucky and Colorado.

An interview was held on October 12<sup>th</sup> with Brookings, SD.

We have reached out to another community but they declined to be interviewed. It seems the proposed floodway developed with 2D modeling was much wider than their present floodway and it added 135 homes to the floodway. The community objected and the FEMA region agreed to splice in their existing floodway into the mapping.

They are happy with this and do not want to rock the boat.

Joanna indicated she would reach out to MO to see if they have any communities that would be a candidate. They are developing floodways with 2D modeling. [Note: she did but MO indicated that none are fall enough along.]

### CTP Conversation

Joanna indicated that she would like to survey CTPs to get feedback on the CTP Conversation and Social that was held in Raleigh, NC and suggestions for the events in Salt Lake City. She drafted some questions and got some input from Laura Algeo. ASFPM staff have put the questions into Survey Monkey. The ASFPM Communications Manager will send out the survey using the M&ES committee list along with the CTP webinar contact listing. There is no big rush so the plan is to have the blast sent out after Thanksgiving.
