

## Cooperating Technical Partners – ASFPM CTP Subcommittee Monthly Call – January 12, 2026

### CTP virtual conversation

The CTP virtual conversation was held on Nov. 17<sup>th</sup> at noon CST. Brooke consolidated the responses to the breakout sessions and Necolle Maccherone prepared a summary.

The next virtual conversation will be held January 20<sup>th</sup> at noon CST. Glenn indicated that Region V has a call scheduled with region CTPS at 10 am CST on that day. He could pass on any highlights from that call. Joanna indicated that she is familiar with zoom so she could send out the invite and manage the call. Joanna indicated that she could send out an invite to the CTP contact list that we developed for the last virtual call. After the January call we would have a webinar in February. Regular monthly calls would start on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday of the month in March at noon CST.

It was suggested that we again have Meg provide an update regarding what is happening at the federal level.

We discussed having breakout sessions with a maximum of 10 each. We would not have a set of questions this time but have the same questions as a fall back if people were not forthcoming.

*15 min – Breakout rooms – we would select people that go into breakout rooms so that there would be an even distribution*

*15 min – summary of breakout discussions.*

*How are you surviving the lack of a NOFO?*

*Where could ASFPM best support you?*

### Webinar for the January – March timeframe

These presentations would be about 5 minutes each and Laura would be provided 30 minutes to cover the CTP history topic.

### Future topics

We could have a survey at the virtual conversation that would ask for questions.

We discussed having one on AI impact on mapping, FRRD or other flood hazard mapping. We could have one on leadership skills, reflective listening and conflict resolution. Another option is one on training on giving presentations.

### CTP activities at the ASFPM conference

Alan will reach out to the conference planning team regarding when the meeting times needs to be finalized. We discussed changing the time to avoid the conflict with the ASFPM membership meeting. It could be shortened to one hour or moved up 30 minutes so that we would have 90 minutes.
