

## **Cooperating Technical Partners – ASFPM CTP Subcommittee Monthly Call – February 2, 2026**

Attendees: Alan Lulloff, Joanna Rohlf, Brooke Seymour, and Laura Algeo

### **CTP virtual conversation**

The CTP virtual conversation was held on January 20<sup>th</sup> at noon CST. Brooke has provided a summary of one of the breakout sessions. Joanna indicated that AI was used to provide the content of the webinar. However, it did not provide a summary of the breakout session. It was agreed that we would pull together the summaries of the breakout session would focus on what was discussed and not on who was in the breakout sessions. Laura Algeo indicated that we could get a listing of the names of CTPs from the sharepoint site. Joanna went to the sharepoint site and was able to download the contact information for ctps that use the sharepoint site. This can be consolidated with the listing of CTPs that was listing of CTPs prepared for the virtual meeting.

- One item of note is a comment in Brooks breakout summary. Participants asked whether ASFPM could compile data on:
  - How many CTP programs have had to pause or stop work, and
  - How many positions have been lost or are at risk due to grant uncertainty.

Alan indicated that ASFPM could conduct a flash survey to ask 5 to 10 questions that could go out to the CTP contact list compiled.

Meg again provided an update regarding what is happening at the federal level. After her presentation several people left the call highlighting that this is was their primary interest in attending.

We will be having a webinar in February. On a previous call it was agreed that regular monthly calls would start on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday of the month in March at noon CST.

We had a poll asking attendees to vote on preferences for CTP webinars. Artificial Intelligence impact on Mapping got the most votes, Future of Flood Risk Data (or other mapping effort) 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 2D modeling outreach 3<sup>rd</sup>.

We need some suggested speakers for the first two voted on.

### **CTP conversation**

Alan has talked to Sara regarding the timing of the CTP conversation. It could be moved to coincide with the afternoon committee co-chairs meetings. We agreed that that is what we would like to do.

The poll regarding which night would be best did not have a clear consensus.

### **CTP webinar**

Laura provided a draft of her presentation. The only comment provided was that on some slides the font could be increased. People can provide comments to Laura this week.

We agreed that for the webinar each would provide their presentation to Kevin. Each speaker would share their screen but that the consolidated presentation would be a backup. A tech check is scheduled for the 17<sup>th</sup> so speakers can practice sharing their screen.

Alan will provide information on some funding options available (e.g. the NC approach where there is a surcharge on documents filed with the register of deeds office that goes to a fund that supports floodplain mapping.),

Texas has their own guidance on BLE mapping that Manuel can share.
